- Suggestion: hold a meeting at the MA Fusion Center
 - AFTER ACTION: set up a meeting for 2017 (L.Martiniello)
- Targeted Round Table: Narcan
 - Led off by Eric Anderson (BMC) and Bonnie Michelman and John Driscoll (MGH)
 - Currently rolled out program: BMC, MGH
 - In Process of rolling out program: Cambridge Health Alliance, BWH
 - Good Samaritan Law will cover officers
 - Look at statistics and see if your data warrants officers to carry narcan
 - Attorney General Maura Healey released a 5-minute video on narcan
 - If you roll out narcan, it has to be only one part of a comprehensive program including a risk assessment of your campus
 - i.e. locking bathrooms
 - Lessons Learned:
 - Do no re-invent the wheel, look to other hospital's policies and guidelines
 - Make Case to Senior Leadership
 - Review regulatory mandates
 - Need a MD Champion
 - Think about how to Deploy narcan (supervisors only, SSPOs/SPOs only, all officers, etc.)
